# Historically Black Colleges and Universities Embrace Affordable Access Programs 

Nearly half of nation's HBCUs rely on textbook access programs to help cut costs, improve outcomes for students

More than 45 HBCUs around the country depend on affordable access programs to help support students' learning needs and make college more affordable. Here are the facts:

- $\mathbf{\$ 3 0}$ Million: Affordable access programs helped students at participating HBCUs save more than $\$ 30$ million $^{1}$ on course materials in the 2022-2023 school year.
- 100,000+ Students: Over 100,000 students $^{2}$ at participating HBCUs benefit from access programs, which ensure they have all their required course materials on or before the first day of classes at competitive below-market prices.
- 82\%: A survey ${ }^{3}$ of students at HBCU schools offering affordable access programs found $82 \%$ of students said access programs helped lower the cost of their course materials, and $85 \%$ felt better prepared for the academic term.
- 76\%: The same survey also found more than three-quarters of students agreed the access program helped them achieve better grades.
